RE: 2009-2010 Annual Scholarship Awards

The National Alumni Association, Inc. is pleased to announce the offering of new scholarships, to be awarded for the 2009-2010 academic school year.

North Carolina Central University Alumni Association offers several "National Alumni Scholarships" to students at North Carolina Central University. The scholarships vary in amount and may be renewable for up to four years. Recipients of these awards are designated "National Alumni Scholars". Though the majority of the National Alumni Scholarship awards made annually will be to incoming freshman students, applications are acceptable from any student regardless of classification or academic interest. All alumni scholars are required to carry a full class load.

The Scholarship Committee will select scholarship recipients from the pool of applicants. Applications should be submitted to the National Alumni Association, Inc., PO Box 19795, Durham, NC 27707. We will in turn review the applications to see that eligibility requirements are met.

The deadline for applying for the National Alumni scholarship is **May 15, 2009**; which is an extension of the initial **March 15, 2009** deadline date. Because the initial date has been extended, the date for notifications will be **June 15, 2009**.

We recognize that even this extended deadline will be too soon for many students, but we hope there will be some students able to take advantage of this opportunity this year.
